Shell's Safety Management System is a set of critical documents outlining procedures to be followed to ensure safety during normal operation, maintenance, and emergency situations. Frequent and essential changes to these documents presents the challenge to Shell of ensuring that the latest information is in use at all times.

It is essential for tanker employees to be able to access the relevant procedures quickly and easily to ensure safety of tanker operations, minimize liability to the Company, and protect the environment.

Updated information is compressed and encrypted using Infonic's patented technology, and the resulting files are transmitted via satellite. This is extremely efficient for Shell since its safety documents are updates of files already existing on the ship's computer. Each time the documents are updated, Geo-Replicator only sends the information that has never been sent before across the entire file structure.

Once the small amendment file is created, the Infonic client, on the ship's computer, automatically applies it to the ship's files, ensuring that the most up-to-date documents are always available anywhere in the world.
